




Mercedes vows to continue fundraising and raising awareness until a cure for cancer is found.

In May 1987, Dean obtained his Bachelor's degree in Community and Regional Planning from Iowa State University. After graduation, he was hired by the City as a planner and remained in this role for a few years, he then moved to City Administration as the assistant to City Manager Charles F. Dodge where he worked on City Commission agendas and annexations that fed the City's rapid growth.

In 1992, he obtained his Master of Public Administration degree from Florida Atlantic University and then in July 1994, Dean once again changed positions, becoming the City's first Zoning Administrator. In this role, he coordinated interaction between the Planning and Building Departments, reviewing building permits for compliance with approved site plans and City ordinances. He also helped innumerable residents, businesses and developers navigate the permit and business licensing process. It is estimated he has approved the zoning for over 30,000 businesses in his career. Following Hurricane Andrew, Dean was part of the building permit process that saw Pembroke Pines become the third fastest growing community in the nation. Throughout his career, he has seen the City grow from approximately 53,000 residents to over 170,000 residents today.

Dean is one of the few City employees to have worked in three City Halls, beginning his career at the Taft Street location, then moving to building at 10100 Pines Boulevard and now to the Charles F. Dodge City Center. He is also a graduate of the Miramar-Pembroke Pines Regional Chamber of Commerce's first leadership class in 1988. Dean also served as a liaison to the City's Board of Adjustment and Planning and Zoning Board.

In his personal life, Dean is married to Marilyn and has two adopted children, Douglas and Catherine. Dean and his wife were foster parents providing care to children in need. Dean is a loyal husband, father friend and colleague.
